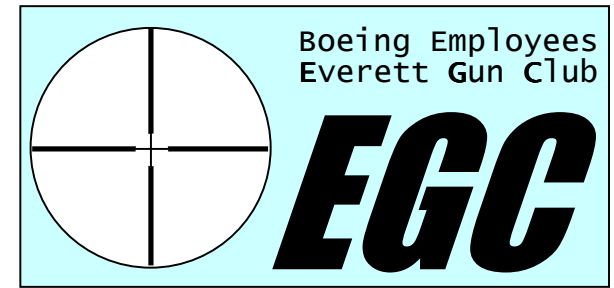
# FIREARM SAFETY

## Training

The club offers training and education courses for both pistol and rifle. Each course is taught by NRA certified instructors and club training staff. Classes are generally kept small (< 12 students) to ensure individual instruction and coaching.

Courses are open to all Boeing employees, retirees, contractors, customers, and families thereof.

**NRA Basic Pistol (10 hrs):** Covers essential safety rules, basic pistol skills, pistol function, parts, and safe ownership and operation. Safety is strongly emphasized. \$60 (*non-members \$80*)

**Basic Personal Protection Inside the Home (18.5 hrs):** Covers the knowledge, attitude, and skills necessary for the safe defensive use of handguns. Includes classroom preparation, range exercises, and discussions with both an attorney and a law enforcement officer. Introduces the student to self-defense concepts beyond the use of a firearm. Completion of the Basic Pistol course is a prerequisite. \$125 (*non-members \$175*)

**Basic Personal Protection Outside the Home (14 hours):** Covers the skills, knowledge and attitude for avoiding confrontations and for safe, effective, responsible, and ethical use of a concealed pistol for self-defense. Includes classroom preparation, legal aspects (attorney presentation), carry modes, concealment, and presenting (drawing) a pistol from concealment. Completion of the Basic Personal Protection Inside the Home is a prerequisite. \$250 (*non-members \$325*)

**Basic Rifle (14 hrs):** For beginning shooters or those wanting to enhance their safety and marksmanship. Features the .22 rifle and precision airgun. Covers the essentials of rifle safety, basic marksmanship, rifle operation, ammunition, rifle storage and cleaning. Parents must accompany children under the age of 18. Note: This is not a Hunter's Ed. Class. \$60 (*non-members \$80*)

## Membership Information

### Eligibility

The club is open to Boeing employees, retirees, and their spouses or dependents. In addition, government, customer, vendor, and contract employees are also eligible.
