Secretary: No Report. The Secretary is stepping down at the end of the year and will transfer all documents to the new Secretary.

Treasurer: The club has approximately \$1000 in checking and \$950 in savings. The club had 88 members in 2009. Prior to the meeting there have been 21 renewals for 2010.

Safety & Training: The club conducted a Basic Personal Protection in the Home Class last month with 4 students. Lorraine is the registrar for the new system of reservations and deposits for classes. The new calendar of classes is now on the website. Don Heinz, an NRA Training Counselor, is working on a Course of Fire for the Personal Protection Outside the Home class. No PPOTH classes have been scheduled as yet. The club held a Turkey Shoot on November 21st, and was conducted with the NRA sporting rifle format. There was a regular sporting rifle class and an “unlimited” class for advanced shooters, or shooters with rifles that do not
