Vice President:

The VP informed us of a coming ballot initiative titled "Gun Violence Prevention." If passed, it would:

- Require a 10 Day Waiting Period for Commonly Owned Rifles
- Establish a Government Registry of Firearms.
- Require Completion of a Training Course to Purchase Rifles.
- Impose up to a \$25 Purchase Fee for Semi-Automatic Rifles.
- Require Gun Owners to Lock Up their Firearms or Face Criminal Charges.
- Restrict Adults Aged 18-20 from Acquiring Modern Rifles.
- Require "Warnings" for Firearm Purchases.

Show & Tell:

(1) Mel Antonio brought in a Smith & Wesson M&P 380 Shield EZ. It is quite compact and comes with an 8 round magazine. It is available at WCAN for \$469 and may be available cheaper elsewhere. It is currently subject to a safety recall for a problem with the thumb safety. +P and higher pressure loads can make it the safety engage accidentally.



(2) Roman Millett brought an AR-15 bolt carriage group in nickel-boron from Stag Arms. To install, you just disassemble the rifle (as for cleaning) and replace the bolt carriage group when reassembling. Prices quoted ranged from \$175 to \$200. Also noted was a one-day only sale for \$94.
