

Meeting: Membership meeting

The meeting was opened at 5:30 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

## **Discussions:**

(1) South End Gun Club. Steve Morehouse from the BER&PC (Boeing Employees Rifle & Pistol Club) came to discuss how we and they could collaborate. Since Boeing dismantled the Oxbow Recreation Center, they have been meeting monthly (free) in the Burien Elks Club. They have shooting activities, show & tell, and reloading classes (they do reloading at the Elks Club).

It was concluded that merger wouldn't be a good idea due to distance, but sharing projects seemed like a way forward.

- (2) Christmas Party. We discussed whether we wanted to have the usual Christmas party. It was noted that without food, we might not get a quorum for the elections. With that, it was decided to hold a party like last year. It was suggested that RSVP should be required so we could order the appropriate amount of food. (There's been a lot left over in previous years.)
- (3) **2020 Officers Nominations.** The current officers indicated that they were willing to serve another year. They were all nominated and seconded for the December ballot. Additional nominations can be made at the December meeting.
- (4) Insurance. We returned to the question of insurance. BER&PC pays about \$1000 per year for their insurance while we pay nothing. It was explained that we are covered by the Boeing insurance through Boeing Recreation and, when we hold an event, we provide a form from Recreation. BER&PC has gotten separate insurance due to apprehension stemming from an incident from another club (ham radio?) where someone was hurt at an event and an officer lost their house as a result.

- (5) **Desired Activities.** We discussed desired activities.
  - Action shoots
  - Small bore rifle shoots
  - Turkey shoot
  - "Postal" shoots with prizes. Shoot your targets and bring them to the meeting to score.
  - Range cleanup event.

The NRA/Winchester Marksmanship program was mentioned. Most of the program is self-scored and the club could buy the awards.

(6) Goals. Hobey expressed a desire to establish a goal of doing \_\_\_\_ classes or events in 2020. The blank was not filled in during the discussion. Also suggested for early next year was a 1639 course which has become a requirement for firearms purchases in Washington.
